Information will be made clear with all written, sign and spoken language recognised and respected.

Mixed groups will be actively encouraged for all collaborative work.

## **Festivals**

Awareness of festivals celebrated help all children and young people to celebrate and express their cultural and religious identities by providing a wide range of appropriate resource and activities, seeking accurate information where needed.

The setting shall reflect the Multi-cultural Society in which we live.

Medical, cultural and dietary needs will be met and respected. All members will be seen to have a worthwhile contribution. We recognise there are children and young people within the community with special needs and will endeavour to ascertain what part we can play in meeting their needs.

All staff will receive appropriate training.

This policy will be reviewed annually or sooner should the need arise.

Sandmartins will endeavour to challenge any offensive behaviour, language or attitudes with regard to race, ethnicity, nationality, class, religion, culture, gender, language, sexual orientation or disability.
